Brotte Espirit Barville Cotes Du Rhone 2016

Dark ruby with light edges. Medium intensity with aromas of small stone fruits and delicately spicy hints of pepper, thyme and garrigue (bush land). Smooth, warming and elegant. Its aromas recall wild red fruits, dark cherries, forest floor and liquorice. The tannins are soft yet precise. Fruity and Round. Enjoy with a wild mushroom omelet, beef filets, veal stew, or with a dessert of chocolate and cherry cake.

Henri Dubois Brut Champagne NV

A blend of 65% Pinot Noir, 20% Chardonnay, and 15% Pinot Meunier. This champagne sparkler from Epernay, France offers wonderful fruit aromas with fresh crisp character and a long finish.

Chateau Haut Pourjac- Blanc 2018

This merlot-based blend is bright ruby in color with forward scents of cassis, plum and blackcurrant leaf. On the palate it has silky red and black fruits with a hint of tobacco.

Hamilton Creek Zinfandel 2017

Napa's Howell Mountain is famed for it's big, robust, chewy Cabernet Sauvignons - but Zinfandel also thrives in these super-premium vineyards. This is classic and classy Howell Mountain Zin, loaded with brambly blackberry and black raspberry fruit plus plenty of spice and finishing with nicely chewy tannins and a gush of fruit and spice. This is drinking great right now but will shine on for a half-dozen years at least.

Dominum QP Reserva Rioja 2009

Intense garnet-dark cherry red color of great depth. Intense and complex aroma with toasted, spiced and smoked notes of French oak, blending perfectly with the black fruit, chocolate and balsamic notes. In the mouth the attack is gentle, but the wine immediately reveals itself to be full-bodied and meaty, with mature tannins and excellent acidity. Long and persistent, with smoked and spicy notes, and ripe fruit reappearing in the aftertaste. Mineral finish. **WS 90 Pts**
