Commanderie de Bargemone Rose 2018, Provence France

The terrific (and fairly priced) 2018 Coteaux d'Aix en Provence Rose stood out among the 139 rosés I tasted blind during my late February trip to Provence. It combines hints of cantaloupe with cassis in a medium-bodied, silky-textured wine that shows just a hint of leafiness on the finish. The blend is 40% Grenache, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Syrah, 10% Cinsault, and 5% Rolle. **90 Pts Wine Advocate**

Josèph Cattin Pinot Blanc, Alsace France

This sustainably grown Pinot Blanc has lively mineral undertones, crispy green apple notes and it finishes dry as a bone with a refreshing snap of meyer lemon acidity. It pairs perfectly with seafood-based cuisines, fish & white meats! It can also accompany light cheese like gruyère and brie.

3 Brooms Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough, New Zealand

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Chateau le Montiel d'Arsac Haut-Medoc, Bordeaux, France 2015

From the Haut-Médoc, part of the same property as Château d'Arsac in Margaux, this wine is made with the same rich character and intense fruit and structure. It is a dense, powerful wine, full of fruit with a solid background of tannins. It will certainly age, so drink from 2025. Round, fresh, medium-bodied with sweet, cassis, spice and a touch of licorice, this wine is well-priced for Margaux.

Ty Caton Estate Winemaker's Cuveé Cabernet Sauvignon 2016

The 2016 Estate Winemaker's Cuvee meets the palate with rich and full-bodied flavors of black currant, red plums, and cassis, followed by oak notes of cedar and vanilla. These dark flavors produce a lush and velvety textured mouth feel that combine with supple tannins, and leads to a long silky finish.
